Persistent Absence

Yesterday we had to submit our census data to NYCC, which measures school dinner levels, attendance, demand for places etc. One feature that has come from this is the fact that our Persistent Absence (children whose attendance is below 90%) this term is way above what it normally is - 17/68 children. This week's attendance

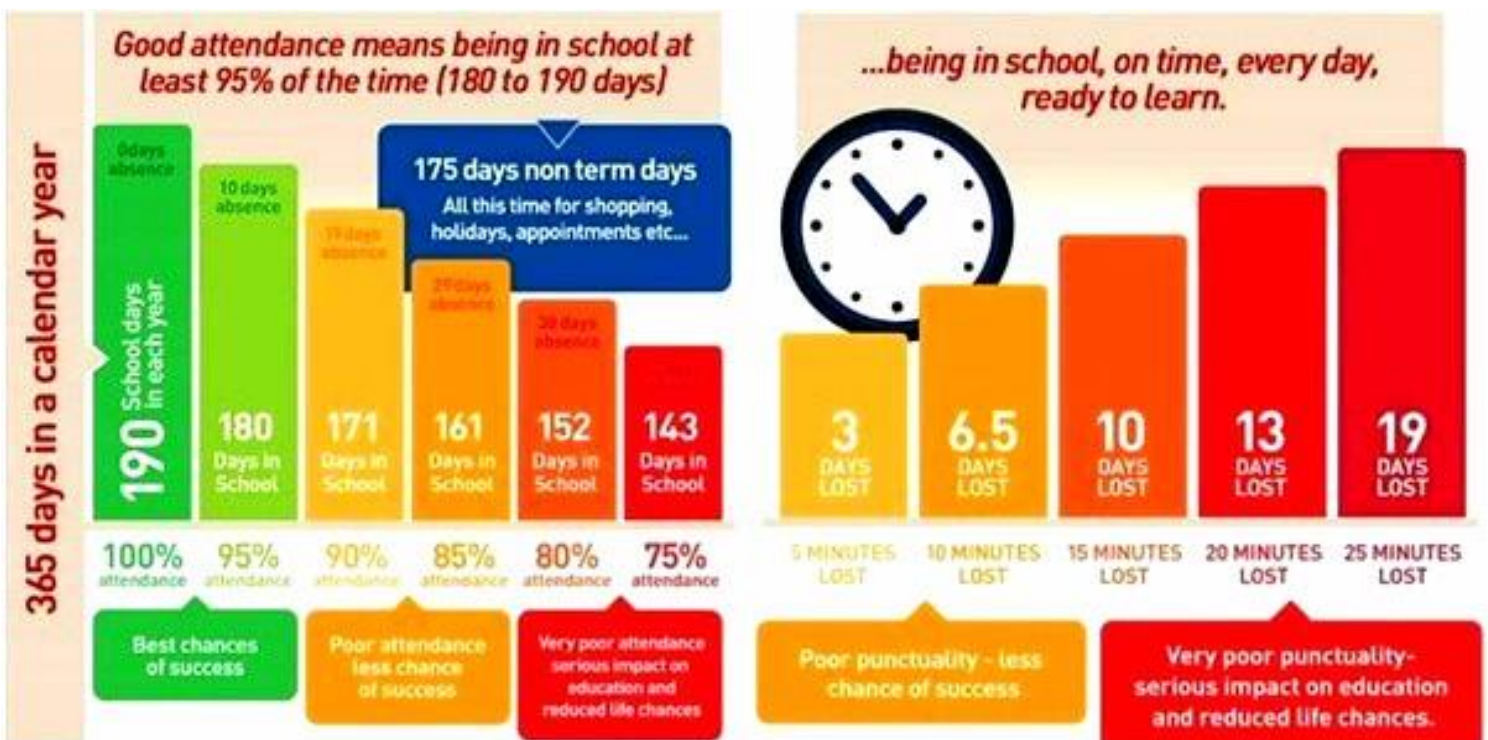


The government expectation for all schools is **96%+** attendance.
