We are really looking forward to hearing about your activities and seeing some of your photographs. Parents/patrons are welcome to come along or to watch the school office to book to speak.

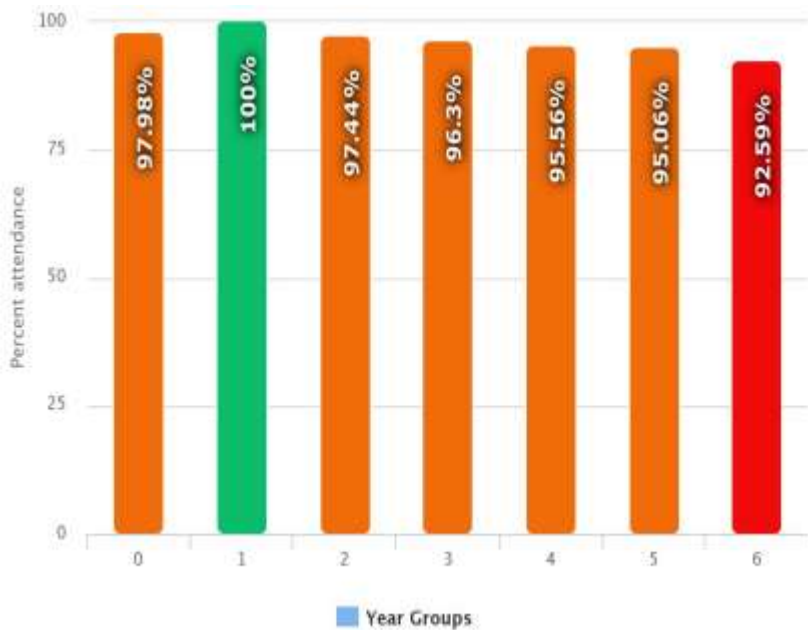
