Hi everybody,

It's been another busy week at school – thankfully largely unaffected by the cold weather!

It was great to see so many children enjoying **Boccia** club last night. This club sums up much of what we are trying to achieve on a whole-school level – giving the children opportunities to challenge themselves in a brand new activity, building new skills and developing that keenness to have a go, or persevere when something seems tricky at first. I'm also glad that they were so much better then me at it! **My Happy Mind**, **Crafts**, **Self-defence** and Friday **Sports** Club have all also started with gusto, with **Enterprise** Club and Class 2 **Sports** starting with a vengeance next week! The counselling sessions have also started for the first group of children.

Unfortunately, one victim of the weather was the Class 1 and 2 **swimming** session scheduled for Thursday afternoon. We received a call on Thursday lunchtime to inform us that their boiler had broken and the pool wasn't warm enough. These swimming assessments will now take place next week.

I must say a huge thank you to you all for helping us keep our **attendance** at a good level. Speaking to colleagues around the area, I know that some are struggling to secure attendance levels as good as ours. We can reference DFE and Local Authority targets but ultimately attending well at school has a massively positive impact on learning.

Plans for **Wild School** are progressing at pace. A yearly overview is currently being developed, incorporating 1 and 2 day expeditions in the forest, alongside the opportunities to 'camp out' which I mentioned previously. We have carefully considered your feedback in the parent questionnaires and are currently finalising a progression of outdoor skills which the children will build upon from Reception to Year 6 – building on those from our previous forest school. These will include shelter building, knot tying, fire lighting, cooking, tool use and bushcraft, alongside observational knowledge of flora and fauna. Our Wild School will be a vehicle to develop these skills, bring other curriculum subjects to life, and develop those personal and interpersonal skills which are so transferrable to all sectors of the workplace.










This week's attendance
