Hi everybody,

It's been another busy and exciting week for the children. On Monday Class 1 celebrated **Earth Day**, a chance to reflect on what we can do to protect the environment at a local and global level. I know that the children really enjoyed making their seed bombs and I look forward to hearing about how well they have grown!

On Tuesday the children got the chance to experience **Science Bus** – a whole range of exciting experiments designed to enthuse and excite the children. Activities like these are important to us in broadening subjects beyond the classroom and making the children realise that science is all around us.

As a Local Authority School, we work closely with School Improvement Advisors. Our allocated advisor, Stuart Anslow, visited us on Monday to look at how our improved curriculum will further develop the children's **Global Knowledge, understanding of Diversity and Aspirations**. These visits are important as they allow us to establish just how effective what we are doing in school is. I'm pleased to say that he was very impressed. The new subject plans will be published on the website soon – in the meantime, if you would like to see them and talk them through, please let me know. Stuart will be back in school next week to look at how effective our **Feedback** is.

Please call the school office to book your place and confirm who will be coming. There will be a small charge of £3.45 per adult, siblings will be free.

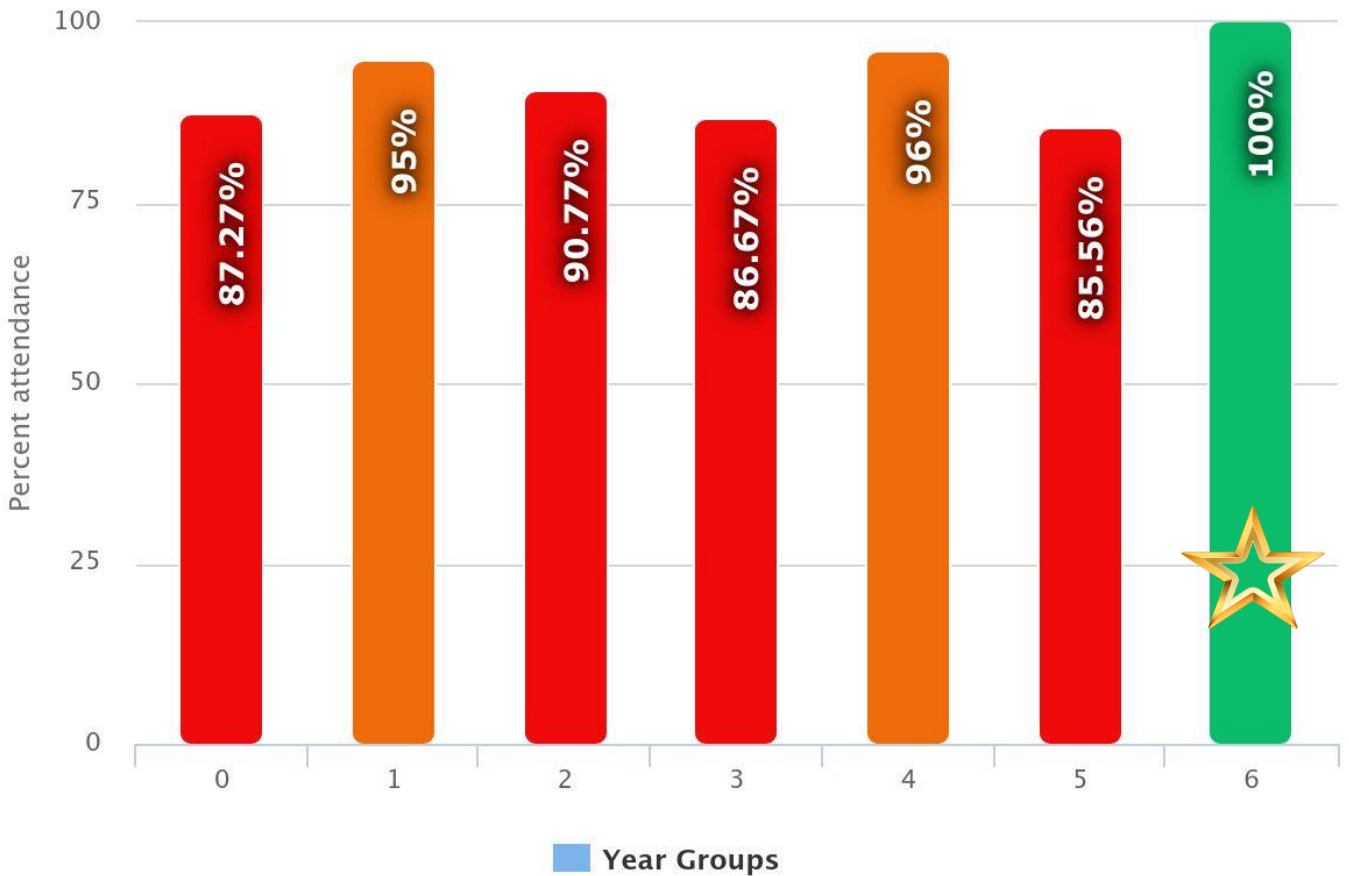

This week's attendance

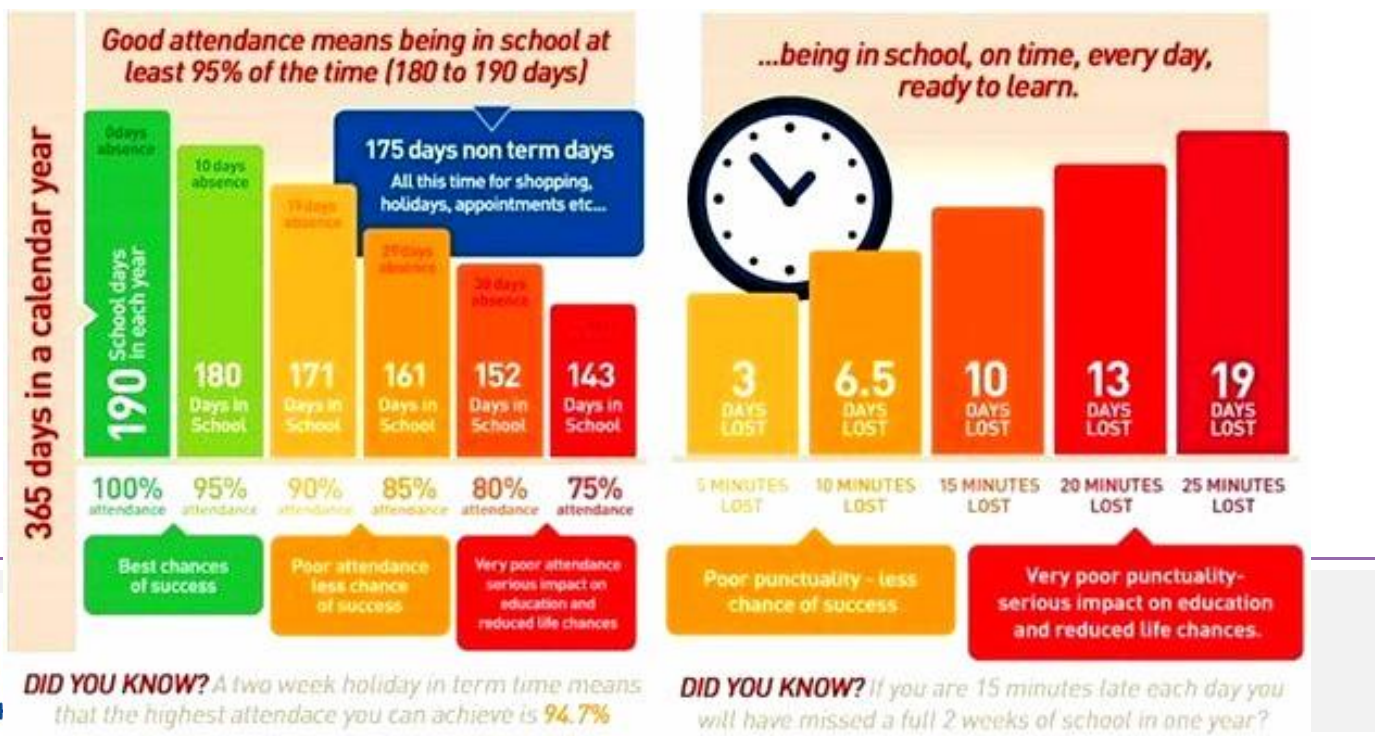


The government expectation for all schools is **96%+** attendance.
